2016-2017 Registration Info & Policies

Student registration is completed online. Registration denotes understanding and acceptance of Teelin's "General Information & Policies" listed on page 2 of this document. Send tuition payable to Teelin: 9303 Sandra Park Road, Perry Hall, MD 21128 (Note: Payment by check or money order only, until we are able to secure an online option.)

REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

Registration is completed online during the open enrollment period of June 3, 2016 – September 5, 2016. A discounted registration fee of \$25 is offered to all families registered by August 1, 2016. Registration fee is \$45 per family after August 1.

STEP ONE: Follow the link to the 2016-2017 Online Registration, available from the Class Schedule page of the Teelin website.

STEP TWO: Login to your family account, or enter your "Family Info" to create an account for your family. You may edit this information at any time by logging into your account using your email address and the password that you designated. (If you forget your password, there is a "forgot my password" link available from the login page.)

STEP THREE: Enter the "Student Info" for each dancer in your family, and then register for class. Be sure to note any prerequisites listed. A discount will be applied automatically to each student who takes multiple full-year classes (10% off second class).

STEP FOUR: Submit with payment within 10 days to complete registration. For convenience, you may complete the bottom half of this page, and send with payment. (Important Note: Acceptance of the online registration agreement denotes understanding of the "General Information and Policies" listed on page 2 of this registration form.)

On the final screen of the online registration, your account balance will be posted. Use the box below to check the calculations for each portion of your tuition balance. Review the payment options, sign this registration form, and either mail with payment **within 10 days** to Teelin, 9303 Sandra Park Road, Perry Hall, MD 21128. (Note: online payment not currently available, coming soon...)

How to calculate your Tuition Balance:

Tuition for total number of classes + \$45 Family Registration Fee (\$25 if prior to Aug 1) + \$60 Costume Fee(s) if applicable = Balance Due (Tuition for each class is listed in chart on Page 2. Only the classes marked with an asterisk* are charged a \$60 costume fee per student per class.)

For each dancer who is taking a second full-year class, 10% of one class will be discounted automatically by the online registration system. Discount applies to a dancer taking multiple full-year classes, not to multiple dancers within a family, nor to additional partial-year classes or company rehearsals.

Payment may be submitted by check or money order, either in the Tuition Box at the studio, or mailed to business address above. If tuition is not received within 10 days of online registration, the student's reservation for a space in that class will be forfeited.

Teelin Irish Dance Company tuition is \$555 per dancer, or \$350 for Junior Troupe. Families may discount this tuition by volunteering 10 service hours, thereby reducing the company dancer tuition fee to \$505 per dancer (\$300 Junior Troupe). This discount is for company tuition only, not other classes.

*Denotes that students in this class are charged an additional \$60 costume fee. Actual costume fee may be adjusted when costumes are ordered. **Performance Class will perform two separate numbers in the Spring Show, and will therefore need to purchase two separate costumes for that class: \$120 costume fee. All students in AB/N/PW, N/PW or Champ classes must have a competition costume appropriate for their level to wear in the Teelin Spring Show. Purchase of a competition costume is each dancer's independent responsibility.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND POLICIES

LIABILITY

Teelin cannot be held liable for dancer injury in class or on the premises.

REGISTRATION

Registrations are completed online and payment must be received at the administrative office **within 10 days of online registration** and prior to student attending class. **If payment is not received within 10 days student may be dropped from the class without notice.** Class sizes are limited, therefore prompt registration is recommended to avoid disappointment. Full payment (or commitment to full payment through installment plan) is required at the time of registration. **When registering for a full year class (Sept-June) you are committing to pay for these classes in full even if you drop after the withdrawal period of three weeks.**

COSTUME FEE

All September-to-June classes will participate in the Teelin Spring Show, and some of the partial-year classes will also participate. All students in Beginner, Beginner II, Level 1 or Levels 2&3 classes or Performance Class (x2) must pay a \$60 costume fee at the time of registration, and may be charged an additional fee depending on the costume needs for their class (to be determined by December). All students in Adv Beg, N/PW or Champ classes are required to have a competition costume appropriate to their level, which will be worn in the Spring Show. See the "Feis Info" pages of the Teelin website for more information about competition costumes. **The Teelin Spring Show will be presented on Sunday, May 7, 2017, at the Jim Rouse Theatre in Columbia, MD.** Please mark the date on your calendar now. Any student unable to perform in the Spring Show must inform Teelin administration in writing by December 1, 2016. After December 1, 2016, the costume fee is non-refundable.

REFUNDS

Teelin reserves the right to cancel any program that does not meet a specific enrollment. A full refund will be made when a class is cancelled by Teelin. Enrolled students are given three weeks of class to determine their commitment. Tuition refunds will not be issued after the third scheduled class of the session if a student or parent decides not to continue, **UNLESS** approved by Teelin for medical emergency situation.

ABSENCE / MAKE-UP CLASSES

If a class is missed, a dancer may attend another class of the same level (or one level below). **Please e-mail kathleen@teelin.com in advance to schedule a make up class.** Make-up classes are discouraged from mid-January through April in level classes due to choreography rehearsals in preparation for the Spring Show.

INCLEMENT WEATHER / INSTRUCTOR INJURY OR ILLNESS

If a class is canceled due to inclement weather or instructor injury/illness, an email will be sent to all registered students. Inclement weather cancellations will also be announced at www.teelin.com and on the answering machine at 443-629-7808. If a class is cancelled due to inclement weather, students may attend a make-up class per the policy stated above.

IMAGES AND RECORDING

From time to time Teelin will take pictures and/or record a Teelin class or event on film or videotape. These pictures and recordings may be used for the promotion and advertising of the school or events which feature dancers from the school. If you do not want your Teelin student to be included in these pictures and/or recordings, the Teelin office **must be informed in writing by a responsible adult at the time of registration.** If at any time during the school year you decide to opt out of having your student be photographed or recorded, Teelin shall still have the right to use any photographs or recordings previously taken of your child. Teelin will use its reasonable efforts to not use any of the prior photographs which feature only your child, but will have the right to use group photographs and/or group recordings which may include your child. Teelin will not photograph and/or record your child once they have received your notice.

TEELIN SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY

We expect Teelin students to set and maintain high ethical standards in their use of social networking. Since social media reaches audiences far beyond the community, students should use social sites responsibly and be accountable for their actions. Enrollment in any Teelin class implies your understanding of and willingness to adhere to the objectives stated below for the duration of the time that you are associated with the Teelin Community.

- Think before you post. Teelin asks students to use discretion when posting to the Internet.
- Do not post or link anything (photos, videos, web pages, audio files, forums, groups, fan pages, etc.) to your social networking sites that you wouldn't want friends, peers, parents, teachers, college admissions officers, or future employers to access. What you present on social networking forums represents you forever.
- Always represent Teelin in a positive manner.
- Do not post photos, links or comments that are profane, sexual, involve drugs or alcohol, or that are insulting or harassing to any Teelin students or teachers.
- Teelin reserves the right to request school-related images or content to be removed from the Internet.
- Videos of dancers performing Teelin solo steps are not to be posted online or e-mailed to anyone outside of Teelin. Non-public (unlisted) video links shared with Teelin dancers are not to be shared with others.
- You may share any public Teelin videos that are posted on the Teelin Facebook Page or the public Youtube Channel. Short video clips from public company performances are also permitted.
- Be aware of liability. You're legally liable for what you post on your own site and on the sites of others. Individual bloggers have been held liable for commentary deemed to be proprietary, copyrighted, defamatory, libelous or obscene (as defined by the courts).

Any concerns regarding infractions of this Social Media Policy should immediately be brought to the attention of either the Teelin Director, or the Teelin Business Manager.
